
South Island Ministry Conference 17th & 18th May 2022

Keynote Speakers:

Andrew & Christine Harrex

Christine has had a lifetime of training in teaching children about Jesus. Growing up in Wellington with Scripture Union staff workers for parents she attended many summer holiday programmes. After training as a secondary teacher, she moved to Dunedin, teaching at Queen's High School for 11 years.
