The Lord Jesus calls us all to follow him. I know you want to do that. He is the one who gives us hope and purpose, healing and life. But in order to follow Jesus we need to get better at recognising and responding to what the Lord is doing – both in the ordinary moments and in the larger decision of our lives. This year the elders and I are calling our church to grow in our ability to discern God’s will together. We need God’s leading as we tackle exciting new opportunities ahead of us. The first step in

discerning where God is leading us together is for each of us to grow in our ability to discern God’s will individually. We do this by keeping close to God. In the words of Romans 12:2 we “let God transform us into new people by changing the way we think. Then we will learn to know God’s will for us, which is good and pleasing and perfect.” Let’s confess anything that could separate us from God: our pride, wrong or hurtful things we do or say. And let’s invest the time needed to pray, read the Bible, be in silence and solitude, celebrate in worship... all those things that help create space for God to speak to us.

In a few weeks we will spend some time in each of our services on discernment. There will also be dedicated prayer and feedback sessions. I look forward to where the Lord will lead us.
