What is this resourcing achieving? We celebrate what God is doing through us. Our Christmas Eve and Christmas Day services presented the good news to 813 people and our Christmas Lunch at the RSA welcomed 93 guests and 20 volunteers. At the last EPIC service of the year 3 young people committed to following Jesus through baptism at the beach and at the first EPIC service for 2019, 2 more young people made the same important step in their faith journeys. We celebrate with all of these people.
