Attention all of the lovely people who work with our children

As a church we are committed to creating a safe environment for both our young people and our awesome volunteers. In order for us to do this well, PCANZ have released a very helpful training resource called "Warrant of Fitness", which all people involved in any ministry to do with children, need to complete. The PCANZ Safety Warrant Fitness Training provides practical tools and insights to assist all those working with children and young people. The training will equip parishes to comply with New Zealand law, the PCANZ's Child Protection Policy and, most importantly, keep our young people, and volunteers safe.

The WOF encompasses essential training on a myriad of topics and will only take around 3 to 4 hours of your time to complete. The WOF training is required for anyone who is over the age of 16 and has dealing with, or potential dealings with, anyone under the age of 18 years of age.

Leeanne will be running a number of WOF workshops in 2020 to ensure that everyone who needs to, has the opportunity to complete this training. The next workshop will be held on:


