Update on the Lunch in Schools programme.

Saddle Hill Foundation Trust (SHFT) were pleased to be able to employ Ronnie Bhogal on a part-time, fixed-term contract for the pilot project of providing nutritional lunches for those needing them in Silverstream school. What we called “compassionate catering” was made possible by the generosity of East Taieri Church members, in giving both money and volunteering their time. This pilot project came to a close at the end of Term 2.

We are pleased to say the School has now received government funding to provide lunches in their school on a sustainable basis. The school have employed Ronnie full-time for the lunch programme and also to teach nutrition in the school. While SHFT are no longer formally involved in this project at this stage, we are delighted to have been a part of getting it off the ground.

Greg Hurley (principal of Silverstream) wrote to us and said: *‘providing good nutritional lunches is making a huge difference... It’s not just the few that arrive without food. Many of the families that do provide good lunches for their children are doing so at the cost of something else- sports fees, electricity bills, clothing...SHFT have been instrumental in their support of the programme and we are eternally grateful for that support. The use of the Hub kitchen was extremely generous and personally I would like to see some way we can pay back that generosity when our nutritional meal programme is running like a well-oiled machine. Maybe we can work on another project that will benefit even more of our community? Please thank all of those that have believed in Ronnie and supported him to support our whanau’.*
