Supervision:

Turning Point offers professional, clinical and pastoral supervision to a wide range of people from various professions. This includes health, education, counselling and support work. We also offer supervision to those in paid and voluntary positions in Christian work. We are all trained, qualified and experienced in supervision.

We all need supportive & accountable people in our lives whether this is found through mutual friendships, colleagues or external independent people who can give us time to unravel, stand back from our work & gain a new perspective.

We all need others, we cannot do this alone We need a safe place to go to be open and honest about our challenges.

There is also a professional & legal necessity to have some form of supervision.

Supervision is made up of two words: 'SUPER' & 'VISION'. Supervision aims to provide a place of helping us regain our vision and to encourage us in our work. Supervision enables us to leave feeling better about ourself & our work.

Supervision is useful because:

- It provides external independent access to someone who is not closely involved in our work
- It provides a safe place for sharing our heart and the burdens of work
- It provides an opportunity to gain a new perspective and problem-solve
- Supervision provides an opportunity for us to consider the relationships we have with people we work with
- It helps us unravel difficult relationship dynamics & their effect on us & our perceptions

Supervision in Christian Work:

In this context supervision provides a space for open and honest discussion and exploration about your role and its impact on your life, family and the people you are called to serve. Supervision has the potential to explore your purpose and goals in ministry.
