Last Saturday, 6,500 mainly young people gathered at Mystery Creek and another 25,000 watched the livestream of The Send, an event of worship and speakers focused on motivating young people for mission. On the day 496 people committed to reach the next generation, 523 to serve children, 951 to reach their local community, and 658 to reach nations. Something is happening. Young people are hearing the call to go! You can watch all 10.5 hours of The Send (or parts of it!). Is God calling you too?

GO in the Spirit


Our 3 week sermon series is on our new Mission Statement: Know, Grow, Go.
