- Refreshing after the conference for those who are organising the event and taking part.





Prayer letter for East Taieri Church-'To Know, To Grow, To Go...'

March 2025

Welcome to the first edition of our bi-monthly prayer letter for all of the ET congregations. You can use this personally in your time with God, with each other, with your prayer partner, in your groups or in your congregations.



Some of these are for future events. For example, the Easter camp is happening in April but now is the time to prepare the ground with praying for our young people and the people leading them. With prayer, working with God we can accomplish much.

God said to Solomon when he was praying for his people, 'If my people who are called by my name will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and heal their land.' (2 Chronicles 7 v 14)

Praying thoughts...Intercession

To intercede is to stand in the space between a person or a situation and God; we are asking something on behalf of someone else. It is a great privilege to pray for others. Jesus is our intercessor who stands before the Father on our behalf and He calls us to the same ministry, to join with Him in partnership to bring in His Kingdom to change people's lives.

We can often be good at telling God what we think we want him to do. I would suggest as you cast your eye over the great things we are doing as a Church and begin to pray for each area mentioned, to pause, bring the area to God, name it and wait to see if there are any things God brings to your mind, before you start to read the list or use it as a shopping list of requests to God! In the presence of a King, we are not the ones who speak first! A good practice is to end your prayers with thanksgiving for all He is and what he has done. This is a declaration of faith in the God who loves us and is working His purposes out, through partnership with Him.

From the Elders...

- Give thanks for all those that serve in various ways, whether it be seen or unseen.
- Give thanks for the staff team and for wisdom, strength and discernment
- That the prodigal people that have left church (and no longer attending anywhere) will come home.
- That God's people would be empowered and refreshed by the Holy Spirit to step out in obedience to Jesus. That we would know the authority we have in the name of Jesus Christ. That we would be bold in doing what Jesus did. That through our love and obedience to Jesus, others would be drawn to Jesus and God would be glorified.
- That we would be spirit lead in all we do and that we can have discernment to know what is of God, and what is of the flesh.
- That each individual may really grow in their relationship with Christ, for strong foundations of faith and that we live our faith each day; that as a body, we are of 'one mind' and that we seek God in our decision making (big and small)
- That we are 'salt and light'; that we love our community and circles of influence as 'Jesus would'- that we have His heart and His insight in our dealings with others. That we can see past 'labels' that society puts on people and see into the heart of the matter. May God give us wisdom in a world of lots of chaos and conflicting ideas.
- That the Lord will raise up volunteers where they are needed throughout all the various ministries of our Church.
- That we are wise in our stewardship of our resources- whether that's money, time, areas of focus and channelling our skills
- For wisdom in moving forward with ET building needs and facilities.
