We do an anonymous question box as part of our 'community times' (a time spent after each main session, speaker and worship). This is a really key part of the camp for us as leaders because it is an insight into the types of questions that our youth have around faith and Christianity. It is always really encouraging as we get questions such as 'how do I talk to God' 'How do I know if I want to be a Christian'. This gives us a great foundation for the rest of the term as we start back up with youth group. Our first Friday back we are attending a combined youth event called For This City which is really well timed as it will back nicely onto Easter Camp. I would like again to thank the generosity of the church for helping get our youth along but also for the generosity of the board to pay for our leaders as I know that is a huge cost. Out of all of the camps we run, Easter Camp will always be a highlight for many of our youth.
